### UPDATE ON REFUGEE FAMILY AND REQUEST FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Late last September the Waterloo Deanery Refugee Committee welcomed our 6<sup>th</sup> family to Canada and got them settled in Cambridge. They are James an electrician and Esperance who is a designer and sewer of clothes and their children Cedric age 8 and Dorcas age 5. They are originally from the Democratic Republic of Congo but had been in a refugee camp in Kenya for many years. The family has done very well with James having upgraded his English and enrolled in Conestoga College for September and Esperance designing, making and marketing her fashions. The children are enrolled in St. Anne's Catholic school. Like all of us this pandemic has caused them a lot of stress but they are managing as well as possible.

St. James' church made a commitment of a donation of \$1000 for 2020 and now the refugee committee needs these funds to complete our commitment to cover all the expenses of this family for one year. It is a difficult time to raise money as many people are out of work, events for raising money are out of the question and church activities are all cancelled. If you are able to contribute to the support of this family it would be greatly appreciated and we would ask that you mail or drop off your contribution to the church with any checks made out to St. James' with a note on the check to say "Refugee Family."
