JEAN IS LEAVING ST. JAMES'

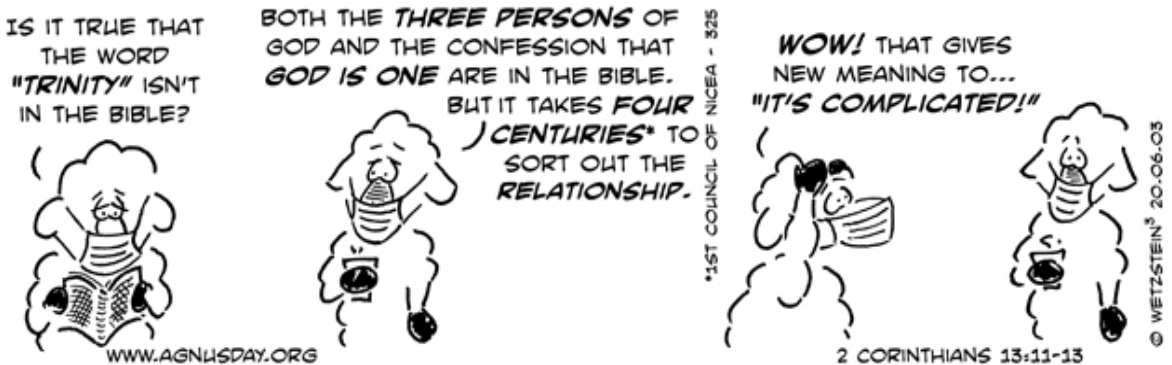

UPDATE ON REFUGEE FAMILY AND REQUEST FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Last Sept. the Waterloo Deanery Refugee Committee welcomed our 6th family to Canada and they settled in Cambridge. James is an electrician and Esperance a designer and sewer of clothes, children Cedric 8 & Dorcas 5. Originally from the Democratic Republic of Congo they had been in a refugee camp in Kenya for years. The family has done well with James upgrading his English & has enrolled in Conestoga College & Esperance designing, making and marketing her fashions. The children are enrolled in St. Anne's Catholic school. Like all of us this pandemic has caused them a lot of stress but they are managing. St. James' made a commitment of a donation of \$1000 for 2020 and now the refugee committee needs these funds to complete our commitment to cover all the expenses of this family for one year. It is a difficult time to raise money as many people are out of work, events for raising money are out of the question and church activities are cancelled. If you are able to contribute to support this family it would be greatly appreciated and we would ask that you mail or drop off your contribution to the church with checks made out to St. James' with a note on the check "Refugee Family." If possible we would like any donations by mid-June. Thank you for your support of prayers, gifts at Christmas and financial assistance.
